



AL FRESCO FIESTA AT MILSOM PLACE

An all summer-long al fresco fiesta is coming to Milsom Place in Bath where you will discover a distinctly Continental vibe. Bask in the sunshine and enjoy fabulous food right in the heart of the city. A feast of flavours includes Italian at Carluccio's and Jamie's Italian, French specialities at Côte Brasserie and an edgy, cosmopolitan atmosphere at CAU, direct from Buenos Aires.

Côte Brasserie offers superb value with its lunch and early evening menus priced at £10.95 for two courses or £12.95 for three. There are *Plats Rapides* for shoppers on a mission like the classical Steak Frites plus a mouth-watering range of seasonal dishes including Artichoke and Goat's Cheese Terrine paired with a glass of Fleurie packed with a spicy, red berry flavour.

Carluccio's has built its reputation by combining signature Italian dishes that pack a punch like Risotto Ai Funghi, together with Chef's Specials such as Cod in Cartoccio cooked in a paper parcel with tomatoes, lemon and pesto. Carluccio's Deli provides just the excuse you need to eat in the open air with their fabulous picnics. With just four hours' notice, you can tuck into a Carluccio's Classic Picnic including Antipasti Misti, chicken poached in lemon and herbs with Apricot Frangipane for a perfect summer evening in the park.

The terrace at Jamie's Italian is a well-kept secret; providing a show-stopping view of the city, and that's before the food arrives! Al fresco Jamie's style serves up Primavera Ravioli - buffalo ricotta & black pepper pasta parcels in a lemony butter sauce with peas, mint & pea shoots - or Jamie's Octopus Ravioli - octopus & squid-ink pasta parcels in a rich shellfish & tomato sauce, topped with hand-picked Cornish crab. For dessert, indulge in a Mighty Mess Sundae with smashed meringue, strawberry compote and vanilla gelato, or Lemon Polenta Cake for a finale with zing.

CAU imports some of the vitality and sense of fun for which Buenos Aires is renowned. The best steaks and burgers in town originate on the Pampas grasslands where Aberdeen Angus cattle are nurtured to perfection. Call in for a cocktail or book a Sunday roast with the family and explore this melting pot of comfort food. For a light bite, check out the Argentinian take on a pasty, empanadas filled with spicy beef; street food anticuchos; a skewer of grilled prawns complemented by papaya salsa; or CAU's ever-popular flatbreads.
